- 5 Sec. 2. (1) On or before May 1, 2016, the department shall submit
- 6 an application to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services of the
- 7 United States Department of Health and Human Services to amend the
- 8 medicaid state plan to provide for utilization of money to allow for
- 9 payments for multisystemic therapy for youth who are eligible for the
- 10 medical assistance program and CHIP pursuant to the federal Children's
- 11 Health Insurance Program Reauthorization Act of 2009, Public Law 111-3,
- 12 <u>as such act existed on January 1, 2015.</u>
- 13 (2) For purposes of this section, CHIP means the Children's Health
- 14 Insurance Program established pursuant to 42 U.S.C. 1397aa et seq., as
- 15 such section existed on January 1, 2015.
- 16 Sec. 3. Original section 68-901, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 17 Supplement, 2014, is repealed.
- 18 Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 19 passed and approved according to law.
