1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to amend section 69,
2 Legislative Bill 657, One Hundred Fourth Legislature, First Session,
3 2015; to appropriate funds to aid in carrying out the provisions of
4 Legislative Bill 591, One Hundred Fourth Legislature, First Session,
5 2015; to change an appropriation; to repeal the original section;
6 and to declare an emergency.
7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 69, Legislative Bill 657, One Hundred Fourth
2 Legislature, First Session, 2015, is amended to read:

15 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$476,785 from the Treasury
16 Management Cash Fund for FY2015-16 and (2) \$206,785 from the Treasury
17 Management Cash Fund for FY2016-17 to the State Treasurer, for Program
18 475, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 591, One
19 Hundred Fourth Legislature, First Session, 2015.

20 Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per
21 diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$50,000
22 for FY2015-16 or \$50,000 for FY2016-17.

23 Sec. 3. There is hereby appropriated \$47,708 from the General Fund
24 for FY2015-16 to the Department of Revenue, for Program 102, to aid in
25 carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 591, One Hundred Fourth
26 Legislature, First Session, 2015.

27 No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems
28 for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this
29 section.

30 Sec. 4. Original section 69, Legislative Bill 657, One Hundred
31 Fourth Legislature, First Session, 2015, is repealed.

1 Sec. 5. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
2 passed and approved according to law.
