A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Workers' Compensation Act; to
amend section 48-1,110, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
2014; to deny compensation in situations of false representation; to
harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original section.
Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1	Section 1. <u>No compensation shall be allowed if, at the time of or</u>
2	in the course of entering into employment or at the time of receiving
3	notice of the removal of conditions from a conditional offer of
4	employment: (1) The employee knowingly and willfully made a false
5	representation as to his or her physical or medical condition; (2) the
6	employer relied upon the false representation and the reliance was a
7	substantial factor in the hiring; and (3) a causal connection existed
8	between the false representation and the injury.
