## **LEGISLATIVE BILL 316**

A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to interstate compacts; to prohibit joining
certain interstate compacts and the sharing of red light camera and
speed camera information with other compact members as prescribed;
and to define terms.
Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1	Section 1. (1) For purposes of this section:
2	<u>(a) Civil fine means a financial penalty imposed by a governmental</u>
3	entity without proving a violation, beyond a reasonable doubt, in court;
4	<u>(b) Interstate compact means a voluntary arrangement between two or</u>
5	more states that becomes the law of each state;
6	<u>(c) Red light camera means an automated camera used to capture an</u>
7	image of a vehicle entering an intersection when the traffic light is
8	signaling red; and
9	<u>(d) Speed camera means an automated camera used to measure and</u>
10	record the speed of vehicles for the purpose of capturing an image of a
11	vehicle that is traveling in excess of the posted speed limit.
12	<u>(2) This state shall not enter into any interstate compact to</u>
13	provide to another state, or governmental entity located in another
14	state, information used to impose or collect a civil fine that results
15	from an alleged violation captured by a red light camera or speed camera.
16	<u>(3) This state shall not provide information used to impose or</u>
17	collect a civil fine that results from a violation captured by a red
18	light camera or speed camera through any existing interstate compact that
19	does not specifically allow or require such information to be shared for
20	<u>that explicit purpose.</u>
