- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to revenue and taxation; to provide for
 reclassification of agricultural land and horticultural land as
 prescribed; and to provide an operative date.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1	Section 1. <u>(1) Any person who owns agricultural land and</u>
2	horticultural land that is classified as cropland for property tax
3	purposes may apply to the county assessor to have up to thirty acres per
4	quarter section of such land reclassified as pasture or rangeland for
5	property tax purposes. The county assessor shall approve such application
6	and reclassify such land if he or she finds the following:
7	<u>(a) The applicant has agreed to plant perennial cover on the</u>
8	property to be reclassified; and
9	(b) The property to be reclassified has been classified as cropland
10	for property tax purposes for at least three of the last five years.
11	(2) Any person receiving reclassification under this section shall
12	reapply to the county assessor for each succeeding year to continue the
13	reclassification and shall supply any documentation necessary to show
14	that perennial cover has been planted as agreed to under subdivision (1)
15	(a) of this section and any other documentation necessary for the county
16	assessor to verify continued eligibility for the reclassification.
17	Sec. 2. This act becomes operative on January 1, 2016.
