- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to brain injury; to define terms; to create a
 council and a fund; and to provide powers and duties.
- 3 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

| 1 | Section 1. For purposes of this act: |
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| 2 | (1) Brain injury has the definition found in section 81-654; |
| 3 | (2) Council means the Brain Injury Council; |
| 4 | (3) Department means the State Department of Education; and |
| 5 | (4) Division means the Division of Rehabilitation Services of the |
| 6 | <u>department.</u> |
| 7 | Sec. 2. (1) The Brain Injury Council is created. The council shall |
| 8 | consist of fifteen members as follows: The director of the division or |
| 9 | his or her designee as a nonvoting, ex officio member, the Director of |
| 10 | Public Health of the Department of Health and Human Services or his or |
| 11 | her designee, and thirteen public members appointed by the Governor. Of |
| 12 | the public members, seven members shall be individuals with a brain |
| 13 | injury or family members of individuals with a brain injury and six |
| 14 | members shall be representatives of the following groups: Public or |
| 15 | private health-related organizations, disability advisory or planning |
| 16 | groups within Nebraska, service providers for individuals with brain |
| 17 | injuries, and the general public. |
| 18 | (2) The Governor shall appoint the public members within ninety days |
| 19 | after the effective date of this act. The Governor shall designate the |
| 20 | initial terms so that three members serve one-year terms, three members |
| 21 | serve two-year terms, three members serve three-year terms, and four |
| 22 | members serve four-year terms. Their successors shall be appointed for |
| 23 | four-year terms. Any vacancy shall be filled from the same category for |
| 24 | the remainder of the unexpired term. Any member of the council shall be |
| 25 | <u>eligible for reappointment.</u> |
| 26 | (3) The council shall select a chairperson and such other officers |
| 27 | as it deems necessary to perform its functions and shall establish rules |
| 28 | and regulations to govern its procedures. The council shall meet at least |

29 <u>four times annually and at any other time as the business of the council</u> 30 <u>requires and at such place as may be established by its chairperson. The</u>

31 public members of the council shall be reimbursed for their actual and

| 1 | necessary expenses pursuant to sections 81-1174 to 81-1177. |
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| 2 | Sec. 3. (1) The council shall provide financial oversight and |
| 3 | technical assistance to the department in the management of the Brain |
| 4 | <u>Injury Trust Fund.</u> |
| 5 | (2) The council shall: |
| 6 | <u>(a) Advise and make recommendations to the department and other</u> |
| 7 | related state agencies on ways to improve and develop services regarding |
| 8 | brain injury, including the coordination of such services between public |
| 9 | and private entities; |
| 10 | (b) Encourage participation by the public through the establishment |
| 11 | of public hearings and other types of community outreach and prevention |
| 12 | <u>activities;</u> |
| 13 | <u>(c) Encourage and stimulate research, public awareness, education,</u> |
| 14 | and prevention activities; |
| 15 | <u>(d) Oversee any programs created under the federal Traumatic Brain</u> |
| 16 | Injury Act of 1996, as the act existed on January 1, 2015, and report to |
| 17 | the federal government regarding such programs; and |
| 18 | <u>(e) Provide fiscal oversight and develop criteria for expenditures</u> |
| 19 | from the Brain Injury Trust Fund. |
| 20 | Sec. 4. (1) The expenditures from the Brain Injury Trust Fund shall |
| 21 | be limited to meeting the needs of individuals with brain injury in |
| 22 | Nebraska and providing for the expenses of the council and division staff |
| 23 | for support of the council. |
| 24 | (2) The criteria for expenditures from the fund may include, but |
| 25 | shall not be limited to: |
| 26 | <u>(a) Funding resource facilitation. A resource facilitator shall be</u> |
| 27 | available to provide ongoing support for individuals with brain injury |
| 28 | and their families for coping with brain injury. A resource facilitator |
| 29 | shall provide a linkage to existing services and increase the capacity of |
| 30 | the state's providers of services to individuals with brain injury by |
| 31 | providing brain-injury-specific information, support, and resources and |

| 1 | enhancing the usage of support commonly available in a community; |
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| 2 | <u>(b) Training service providers to provide appropriate brain injury</u> |
| 3 | <u>services;</u> |
| 4 | <u>(c) Providing funding for the brain injury registry established in</u> |
| 5 | the Brain Injury Registry Act; |
| 6 | <u>(d) Providing activities to promote public awareness of brain injury</u> |
| 7 | and prevention methods; and |
| 8 | <u>(e) Providing support for any brain injury support group which meets</u> |
| 9 | the approval of the council. |
| 10 | (3) The division shall issue a report annually on the status of the |
| 11 | Brain Injury Trust Fund to the Governor and electronically to the |
| 12 | Legislature. |
| 13 | Sec. 5. <u>The Brain Injury Trust Fund is created. The fund shall</u> |
| 14 | include appropriations from the Legislature, transfers authorized by the |
| 15 | Legislature, grants, private contributions, and money from any other |
| 16 | source for brain injury prevention and awareness. The fund shall be used |
| 17 | as provided in this act. Any money in the fund available for investment |
| 18 | shall be invested by the state investment officer pursuant to the |
| 19 | Nebraska Capital Expansion Act and the Nebraska State Funds Investment |
| 20 | <u>Act.</u> |
