- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to insurance; to prohibit employers and
- 2 associations from precluding certain contracts relating to health
- 3 benefit plans; and to provide a duty for the Revisor of Statutes.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- Section 1. <u>Notwithstanding any other provision within Chapter 44</u>,
- 2 <u>an employer or association shall not be precluded from entering into any</u>
- 3 <u>contract</u>, agreement, or arrangement with an agent or broker that provides
- 4 for or results in compensation paid to an agent or broker for the sale of
- 5 <u>a health benefit plan. Such contract, agreement, or arrangement shall be</u>
- 6 <u>in writing and shall specify the compensation amount to be paid and the</u>
- 7 <u>term of such contract, agreement, or arrangement. Such compensation may</u>
- 8 <u>be collected by and directly passed through to the agent or broker by the</u>
- 9 carrier and shall not be considered a part of the premium paid by the
- 10 employer for such health benefit plan.
- 11 Sec. 2. The Revisor of Statutes shall asign section 1 of this act
- 12 to Chapter 44, article 3.
