- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to state intent relating to
- 2 appropriations to the Department of Health and Human Services for
- 3 tobacco use prevention control.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. The Legislature finds and declares that:
- 2 (1) Evidence-based, statewide tobacco prevention and cessation
- 3 programs that are comprehensive, sustained, and accountable have been
- 4 shown to reduce smoking rates, as well as tobacco-related diseases and
- 5 deaths;
- 6 (2) A comprehensive statewide tobacco control program is a
- 7 coordinated effort to establish, promote, and assist tobacco users to
- 8 quit, reduce exposure to secondhand smoke, prevent initiation of tobacco
- 9 use and identify and eliminate tobacco-related racial, ethnic, and socio-
- 10 <u>economic disparities;</u>
- 11 (3) The guidelines for the Centers for Disease Control and
- 12 Prevention of the United State Public Health Service of the United States
- 13 <u>Department of Health and Human Services recommend a significant amount of</u>
- 14 money be appropriated annually to a comprehensive statewide tobacco-
- 15 related public health program in Nebraska; and
- 16 (4) Investing in the Nebraska tobacco use prevention control program
- 17 <u>at the level at which it was originally funded in 2000 will save lives,</u>
- 18 <u>reducing the toll that tobacco takes on Nebraska.</u>
- 19 Sec. 2. It is the intent of the Legislature to include in the
- 20 appropriation to Agency No. 25, Program No. 30, for FY2015-16 \$7,000,000
- 21 Cash Funds and for FY2016-17 \$7,000,000 Cash Funds to use for tobacco use
- 22 prevention control from the Nebraska Health Care Cash Fund.
