Legislative Bill 175 would adopt the Livestock Growth Act to encourage rural economic growth through assisting Livestock Friendly counties who desire livestock development. It would also create a revolving loan fund to provide counties with loans to assist with increased infrastructure costs arising from any improvements needed due to new livestock development.
