The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

The purpose of Legislative Bill 465 is to establish the Electronic Notary Public Act. The Act would set up a process allowing an individual to become an electronic notary public, including registering with the Secretary of State, paying certain fees, taking a course of instruction and passing an examination for such a course. The Act also prescribes what actions can be performed by an electronic notary public and directs the Secretary of State to adopt and promulgate rules and regulations to insure the integrity, security, authenticity of electronic notarizations in accordance with the Act.
