The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB479 strikes language from statute 80-201 that specifies the specific wars or conflicts that can be memorialized on public lands or within public buildings.

The new language allows counties, townships, cities, and villages to erect or aid in the erection of statutes, monuments, or memorials commemorating the services of the members of the armed forces of the United States of America and no longer specifies any conflict or war.
