A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to veterans; to amend section 80-201, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change provisions relating to memorials of veterans; and to repeal the original section. Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 80-201, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

amended to read: 80-201 All counties, townships, cities, and villages of Nebraska may erect or aid in the erection of statues, monuments, or other memorials commemorating the services of the members of the armed forces <u>of the United States of America</u> of the <u>Civil</u>, <u>Spanish-American</u>, <u>or World Wars or the Korean or Vietnam</u> <del>conflict,</del> to be located upon the public lands or within the public buildings within such county, township, city, or village. Sec. 2. Original section 80-201, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

repealed.
