## SPEAKER HADLEY PRESIDING

SPEAKER HADLEY: GOOD MORNING, LADIES AND GENTLEMEN. WELCOME TO THE GEORGE W. NORRIS LEGISLATIVE CHAMBER FOR THE TWENTY-THIRD DAY OF THE ONE HUNDRED FOURTH LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION. SPEAKER HADLEY: THANK YOU, MR. CLERK. WE WILL NOW PROCEED TO THE FIRST ITEM ON THE AGENDA.

CLERK: MR. PRESIDENT, SENATOR SEILER WOULD MOVE TO WITHDRAW LB976. [LB976]

SPEAKER HADLEY: SENATOR SEILER, YOU'RE RECOGNIZED TO OPEN ON YOUR MOTION TO WITHDRAW. [LB976]

SENATOR SEILER: MR. SPEAKER, MEMBERS OF THE UNICAMERAL, I INTRODUCED LB976. IT'S A BILL TO PUT IN STATUTE THE PROCESS OF SEQUESTERING A JURY. IT'S ALSO IN THE NJI, THE NEBRASKA JURY INSTRUCTIONS. AND ONE OF THE MAJOR PUSHERS OF THE BILL HAS DECIDED THAT THEY WOULD RATHER WITHDRAW THIS BILL AND LOOK IT OVER SOME MORE AND NOT TRY AND PUT IT THROUGH THIS TERM.
