A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Medical Assistance Act; to amend section 68-901, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2017, as amended by section 1, Initiative Law 2018, No. 427; to require a protocol for individuals eligible for medical parole; and to repeal the original section. Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 68-901, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2017, as amended by section 1, Initiative Law 2018, No. 427, is amended to read: 68-901 Sections 68-901 to 68-991, and section 2 of this act, and section 2 of this act shall be known and may be cited as the Medical Assistance Act.

Sec. 2. The Division of Medicaid and Long-Term Care of the Department of Health and Human Services shall, in consultation with the Department of Correctional Services, develop a protocol to assist an individual who is eligible for medical parole pursuant to section 83-1,110.02 to apply for and receive benefits under the Medical Assistance Act.

Sec. 3. Original section 68-901, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2017, as amended by section 1, Initiative Law 2018, No. 427, is repealed.
