A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Medical Assistance Act; to amend section 68-994, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2020; to change the limitation on addition of long-term care services and supports to the medicaid managed care program; to repeal the original section; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 68-994, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2020, is amended to read:

68-994 Until July 1, 2023 2021, the department shall not add long-term care services and supports to the medicaid managed care program. For purposes of this section, long-term care services and supports includes services of a skilled nursing facility, a nursing facility, and an assisted-living facility and home and community-based services.

Sec. 2. Original section 68-994, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2020, is repealed.

Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when passed and approved according to law.
