LB1335, introduced by Senator Moser, amends sections 37-801 and 37-802 to exempt transportation infrastructure projects from application of the Nongame and Endangered Species Act (the Act) by amendments to sections 37-801 and 37-802. LB1335 provides an exemption from the Act's provisions for certain transportation infrastructure including highway right-of-way, which are the narrow strips of publicly owned land alongside the road, which are not considered critical habitat for affected species.

LB1335 adds and clarifies procedures, requirements, terms and definitions to the Act, including definitions for transportation infrastructure and exempt agency and political subdivision that are exempt from application of the Act on certain existing infrastructure related projects, with proper notice and procedures.

Explanation of amendments:

AM2947 adds structural context and includes the tool of incidental take similar to federal regulations that allow it. It narrows the exempted party definitions to define that they only apply if an entity is directly connected with a Department of Transportation project.
