Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB1004 as amended by AM2551 and AM2840, clarifies the following requirements for a motorcycle/moped rider to be able to ride without a protective helmet:

- Riders who have acquired a Nebraska Class M license prior to May 1, 2024 may submit proof of completion of a three-hour basic Motorcycle Safety Foundation eCourse (3-hours) to the Nebraska Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV);
- Riders who have acquired a Nebraska Class M license after May 1, 2024 must submit proof of completion of the full 14-hour basic Motorcycle Safety Education Course to the DMV (which consists of 4 classroom hours plus 10-hours riding); **or**
- Be a non-resident of Nebraska who has a license to operate a motorcycle issued by another state.

Additionally, the amended bill requires motorcycle/moped passengers to wear a protective helmet unless the following conditions have been met:

- The passenger is 21 years or age or older; **and**
- The passenger is riding on a motorcycle/moped with a rider who has met all the requirements of this bill to not wear a protective helmet, unless they choose to do so.

All passengers under the age of 21 are required to wear an approved protective helmet. Furthermore, all riders and passengers regardless of age, must wear protective eyeglasses/goggles, or have a windshield.

This bill as amended has an emergency clause.

There would be no fiscal impact from the amended version of LB1004.
