1	Section 1. (1) For purposes of this section:
2	<u>(a)(i) Employer means a person engaged in an industry who has</u>
3	fifteen or more employees for each working day in each of twenty or more
4	calendar weeks in the current or preceding calendar year, any agent of
5	such a person, and any party whose business is financed in whole or in
6	part under the Nebraska Investment Finance Authority Act regardless of
7	<u>the number of employees and shall include the State of Nebraska,</u>
8	governmental agencies, and political subdivisions.
9	(ii) Employer does not include (A) the United States, a corporation
10	wholly owned by the government of the United States, or an Indian tribe
11	<u>or (B) a bona fide private membership club, other than a labor</u>
12	organization, which is exempt from taxation under section 501(c) of the
13	<u>Internal Revenue Code;</u>
14	(b) Family member means and includes a biological, adopted, or
15	foster child, a stepchild, or a legal ward of an employee or the
16	employee's spouse or a person to whom the employee or the employee's
17	<u>spouse stood in loco parentis when such person was a minor child,</u>
18	regardless of the age or dependency status of such child, stepchild,
19	<u>legal ward, or person;</u>
20	<u>(c) Labor organization has the same meaning as in section 48-1102;</u>
21	<u>(d) School means a public, private, denominational, or parochial</u>
22	school which meets the requirements for accreditation or approval
23	prescribed in Chapter 79; and
24	<u>(e) School activities leave means leave taken by an employee for</u>
25	school-related activities of a family member, including, but not limited
26	to, parent-teacher conferences, disciplinary meetings or proceedings,
27	extracurricular or athletic competitions or events, volunteer activities,
28	and orientation programs.
29	<u>(2) An employer shall grant each employee a minimum of twenty hours</u>
30	<u>of paid school activities leave in each calendar year.</u>

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
