## LEGISLATIVE BILL 1238

Approved by the Governor March 21, 1972

Introduced by Maurice A. Kremer, 34th District

AN ACT to amend section 46-609, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to irrigation; to provide for spacing of replacement wells as prescribed; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 46-609, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

46-609. After September 20, 1957, no irrigation well shall be drilled upon any land in this state within six hundred feet of any other irrigation well except any well the water from which is used solely for domestic, culinary, stock use on a ranch or farm, or the watering of lawns and gardens for family use or profit where the area to be irrigated does not exceed two acres and except as provided in section 46-610; <u>Provided</u>, that any <u>irrigation well which replaces an irrigation well drilled</u> <u>prior to September 20, 1957, and which is less than six</u> <u>hundred feet from another irrigation well shall be</u> <u>drilled within fifty feet of the old well</u>.

Sec. 2. That original section 46-609, Reissue Bevised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
