AN ACT to amend section 50-111, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to the Legislature; to eliminate restriction on number of employees; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 50-111, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

50-111. The officers and employees of the Legislature shall consist of a speaker, chief clerk, assistant clerk, sergeant at arms, doorkeeper, engrossing and enrolling clerk, chaplain, and such other officers and employees,-not--exceeding--seventy-five--in number, as may be deemed necessary for the proper transaction of business, such other officers or employees to be elected by the Legislature. Such employees and officers shall be recommended to the Legislature by the Executive Board of the Legislative Council.

Sec. 2. That original section 50-111, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
