AN ACT to amend section 79-4,122, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to schools; to redefine State Fire Day and define Fire Recognition Day; to provide for observance of such days; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 79-4,122, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

79-4,122. For the purpose of creating public sentiment and calling public attention to the great damage caused both to life and property by fire, the first Friday before Fire Recognition Day in-November shall be designated and known as State Fire Day. This day shall be observed by the public, private, and parochial schools of the state with exercises appropriate to the subject and the day. The second Saturday in May shall be designated and known as Fire Recognition Day, and exercises appropriate for the subject and day may be exercised by any fire department.

Sec. 2. That original section 79-4,122, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
