PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? The question is, shall LB 8 be advanced. Record your vote. Have you all voted? Mr. Clerk, please record the vote.

CLERK: Mr. President, 34 ayes, 0 nays, 15 not voting.

PRESIDENT: LB 8 shall be advanced to E & R.

CLERK: LB 9. Title read. There are no amendments.

SENATOR MAHONEY: Mr. President, I move that LB 9 be advanced to E & R for initial review.

PRESIDENT: Second.

SENATOR MAHONEY: Is there any discussion? I can just go ahead and explain it. LB 9 is a revisor bill as the previous bills which corrects an internal reference by adding a reference to Section 28-549 and deleting a reference to 54-549. Section 54-159 to 54-168 to which LB 9 refers are provisions of feedlot registrations which were enacted by LB 934 of our last session, 1974's Legislature. The additional reference to Section 28-549 is a reference to penalty section for altering marks or brands of stock, while the deleted Section 54-549 is a reference to a section of the Statute which does not exist.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? The question is shall LB 8 be advanced. Record your vote. Excuse me, LB 9. Have you all voted? Let the Clerk record your vote.

CLERK: 37 ayes, 0 nays, 12 not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 9 is advanced to E & R.

CLERK: LB 10. Title read. There are no committee amendments or other amendments.

PRESIDENT: The question is what shall we do with LB 10.

SENATOR MAHONEY: Mr. President, I move that LB 10 be advanced to E & R for initial review.

PRESIDENT: Second. Senator Mahoney.

SENATOR MAHONEY: Mr. President, LB 10 is a revisor bill which is an act to repeal Section 53-112.03 of the Revised Statute of 1943 which refers to the time that a salary increase will be effective for members of the Liquor Control Commission. This section permits a change in salary to become effective as soon as the same can be operative under the Constitution of the State of Nebraska.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? The question is shall LB 10 be advanced to E & R. Record your vote. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 39 ayes, 0 nays, 10 not voting.

PRESIDENT: LB 10 is advanced to E & R.

CLERK: LB 11. Read title. There are no committee amendments or other amendments pending.

PRESIDENT: What shall we do with LB 11.

SENATOR MAHONEY: Mr. President, I move that LB 11 be advanced
