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rule change will be taken up. We have it and about twenty other proposed rule changes from members of the body that are all going to be heard next week. I happen to agree very strongly with Senator Syas that this rule change is necessary and it's going to be one of the ones--it's already drafted and he will be allowed to appear and we will try to get it taken care of.

PRESIDENT: And you will give him notice of his proposal.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Oh yes. Notice of his proposal.

PRESIDENT: Senator Schmit, for what purpose do you arise, sir?

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, is it in order for me to ask Senator Swigart a question on the Resolution.

PRESIDENT: It has been passed. I would say it is not in order but if it is a quick informational question, the chair will indulge it.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Well, it may not be a quick question, Mr. President, so I will pass.

PRESIDENT: I'm sure it would be helpful but the Resolution has passed so I don't think it would be in order, Senator.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Thank you, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Koch, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR KOCH: Only to reaffirm Senator Syas' remarks.

PRESIDENT: And you will be present at the Rules Committee hearing?

SENATOR KOCH: If the chairman of the Rules Committee calls that hearing, I very much intend to attend.

PRESIDENT: Senator Burrows, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR BURROWS: Mr. Speaker, I wish to amend the Resolution with an additional section.

PRESIDENT: You are out of order, Senator, it's been passed. The Resolution has been passed. It cannot be amended. Introduction of bills.

CLERK: None, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Consideration of bills on Select File. Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the amendment to LB 59.

PRESIDENT: There has been a motion to--excuse me, this is the amendment of the Committee. Is there any discussion. Excuse me, Senator Schmit, was your light left on or is it-- All right, the question is the adoption of amendments to LB 59. All in favor signify by saying aye. Contrary. The amendments are adopted. Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move that LB 59 be advanced to E & R for engrossing.
