PRESIDENT: The question is shall LB 82 as amended be advanced to E & R initial. Record your vote. Have you voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 5 nays, 9 not voting.

PRESIDENT: LB 82 as amended shall be advanced to E & R Initial. Members of the body indulge me a personal privilege. On the floor under the South balcony are two of Nebraska's most distinguished citizens, the chairman of the Adams County Board, Ed Lightner, and the mayor of the great city of Hastings, Montl Malouf. Welcome to the Legislature, gentlemen. LB 103.

CLERK: LB 103. Introduced by Herbert J. Duis of the 39th District. Read title. There are no committee amendments or other amendments.

PRESIDENT: The chair recognizes Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, I move the bill LB 103 be advanced from General File to E & R Initial. Gentlemen and ladies of the Legislature, this bill was necessitated because of the word change in the school district's treasurer's bonding. The word "less" was put in instead of the word "more" and actually what happened is this. By the insertion of this word which I believe was done without thought at that particular time is that at the present time the school district treasurer must post a bond in twice the amount of any money he should have in possession at any one time whereas if you will notice on Page 2 in regard to the state treasurer's bond, it is the other way around. So consequently we did not feel as though it was necessary for the school treasurer to post a bond in twice the amount of any money he might have in possession at his time even though it would not apply to the state treasurer of Nebraska. We believe it was an error at the time it was made so that is the reasoning behind the change and it necessitated the change of the word.

PRESIDENT: The question is shall LB 103 advance to E & R Initial. Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: May I propose an amendment at this time, sir.

PRESIDENT: Yes.

SENATOR DUIS: I would propose the amendment to add the emergency clause.

PRESIDENT: That requires a machine vote. Shall the amendment to 103 adding the emergency clause be adopted. Record your vote. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 36 ayes, 0 nays, 13 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The chair recognizes Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, I ask that the LB 103 as amended be advanced to E & R Initial.
