CLERK: 28 ayes on motion to advance.

PRESIDENT: LB 208, as amended, shall advance to E & R initial.

CLERK: (mic inactivated) . . . LB 17 is Senator Marsh's bill who is already left.

SENATOR SYAS: (mic inactivated) . . . for it to be held until she comes back. That's all I was gonna do.

PRESIDENT: Is there any objection? Seeing none, it shall be so held. LB 90.

CLERK: Read bill.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Rasmussen.

SENATOR RASMUSSEN: Mr. President, members of the body, there are four changes which are actually word changes in four sections of bills that have been here. The one -- the first one -- they are in your bill book, but I'll read them briefly. The one is that the county service officers would be . . .

PRESIDENT: For what purpose do you arise, Senator Simpson?

SENATOR SIMPSON: (mic inactivated) . . . Mr. President, where we don't have these in the book. I'm not sure what they are and I think that under the Rules we should wait until they are in the book before we take the bill up.

PRESIDENT: Alright. The Clerk advises me that they are not all in all of your books. Senator Rasmussen.

SENATOR RASMUSSEN: Mr. President, I would suggest we wait until tomorrow so that everyone has the explanation of the amendments.

PRESIDENT: Is there any objection to laying the amendment and the bill over until tomorrow? Seeing none, LB 90 is laid over.

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Constitutional Revision reports we have examined LB 12 and recommend that it be placed on General File as amended. Signed, Senator Syas, Chairman.

Mr. President, your Public Works Committee gives notice of hearings set for February and March. Signed, Senator Kremer.

Mr. President, I move to return LB 145 to Select File for a specific amendment, to strike lines 3,4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 on page 5. Signed, Senator Kelly.
