PRESIDENT: The Legislature will please be in order. All rise for our opening prayer by our Chaplain.

CHAPLAIN: Prayer given.

PRESIDENT: Roll call. Record your presence, please. Have you all indicated your presence. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: A quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Correction of the Journal. Is there any correction of the Journal from the floor. Seeing none, the Journal shall stand. Petitions and memorials.

CLERK: A communication from the Executive Office addressed to Vincent Brown, Clerk of the Legislature. Read. See Page 392, Journal. Another letter addressed to Mr. President, Mr. Speaker. Read. See Page 392, Journal. Mr. President, your Committee on Labor to whom was referred LB 127 instructs me to report the same to the Legislature the recommendation it be advanced to General File as amended. Signed Senator Maresh, Chairman. Mr. President, your committee on Enrollment and Review reports that we have examined and reviewed LB 190 and recommend that it be placed on Select File as amended. 90 Select File as amended. 94 Select File. 119 Select File as amended. Mr. President, notice of Committee Hearings. Your Rules Committee gives notice that on February 6th at 12:30, this is today at 12:30, at 1019 for the purpose of considering proposed rule changes. Signed Senator DeCamp. Mr. President, your committee on Revenue gives notice of hearings for February 19th and the 26th. Signed Senator Carsten, Chairman. Mr. President, Retirement Committee gives notice of hearings set for March 4th and 5th, and February 14th, 21st and 24th. Signed Senator Hasebroock, Chairman. That is all, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Bills on Final Reading.

CLERK: LB 42. Read.

PRESIDENT: Senator Duis, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR DUIS: Good morning, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Good morning, Senator.

SENATOR DUIS: I rise because LB 59 does not appear to have the emergency clause on it and I am wondering if it is all right for me to ask to have this legislative bill returned to Select File and I would make such a motion for the purpose of putting the emergency clause on. I think it is necessary in order to get the distribution. So I would make the motion. I would ask unanimous consent or make the motion, whichever is proper, to return 59 to Select File for a specific amendment.

PRESIDENT: It will be a machine vote which takes 25 votes. The motion is to return LB 59 to Select File for the purpose of adding the emergency clause. Record your vote. Have you voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 38 ayes. 0 nays on the motion to return for a specific amendment.

PRESIDENT: LB 59 shall be so returned to Select File. LB 92 on Final Reading.

CLERK: LB 92. Final Reading. Roll call vote taken. See Pages 396 and 397, Journal. (Mike turned off) Roll call vote taken on LB 126. See Page 399, Journal. 23 ayes, 21 nays, Mr. President.
