SENATOR MARESH: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, Senator Lewis said it very well. I think we should listen to individuals and not just to special interest groups and people with lot of power. I would say that, probably, our Labor Committee is very much--is very much in favor of doing this because we have two other bills that are being heard tomorrow that was just brought to us by one person and, probably, the Labor Committee will be criticized for this but I think anytime there is a problem in some area where the Legislature should take a look and how else can we take a look at a problem, if we do not have a hearing, and have the people come in and tell us what is wrong and, so I move that this bill will be introduced.

SPEAKER: All right. The motion before us is to introduce the bill. All in favor vote aye. Those opposed, vote no. Voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Simpson voting aye.

SPEAKER: It takes 30 votes. Have you all voted? I am only holding it open because nobody seems to be opposing, just not voting. Senator Maresh.

SENATOR MARESH: Mr. Speaker, a Call of the House, please.

SPEAKER: Senator Maresh has asked for a Call of the House. Do I have five hands? The clerk will clear the Board. Motion is to put the House under Call. All in favor vote aye. Those opposed vote no. Voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Simpson voting aye.

SPEAKER: The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 21 ayes, 1 nay, to go under Call.

SPEAKER: The House is under Call. All Senators will take their seats. The Clerk will clear the Board. You will show your presence on the Board. Senator Fowler voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Fowler voting aye.

SPEAKER: Senator Maresh.

SENATOR MARESH: Mr. Speaker, I move that the Call be Raised.

SPEAKER: Senator Mills voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Mills voting aye.

SPEAKER: The motion is to Raise the Call. All in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Simpson voting aye to Raise the Call.
