CLERK: Voting aye Senators Barnett, Burrows, Cavanaugh, Clark, DeCamp, Dickinson, Fitzgerald, Fowler, George, Goodrich, Hasebroock, Koch, F. Lewis, R. Lewis, Mahoney, Maresh, Marsh, Marvel, Moylan, Rasmussen, Schmit, Simpson, Skarda, Stoney, Swigart, and Wiltse.

Voting nay Senators Anderson, Bereuter, Burbach, Cope, Dworak, Kennedy, Keyes, Kime, Luedtke, Mills, Murphy, Nichol, Rumery, Savage, Stull, Syas, and Warner.

Not voting Senators Carsten, Chambers, Duis, Johnson, Kelly, and Kremer.

26 ayes, 17 nays, 6 not voting.

PRESIDENT: We are going to move off of General File. Oh, alright. Well it's Senator Luedtke's bill. It was. There is a motion to advance the bill as amended. All in favor signify by saying aye. Excuse me, roll call vote. Senator Warner. For what purpose . . . the Chair recognizes Senator Warner.
