CLERK: 12 ayes, 16 nays.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Motion fails. Question is now, shall LB 28 be advanced to E & R for initial. Senator Kelly.

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, one short closing let's just keep in mind what we're trying to do. There are most people that have health and accident insurance that have no choice. They just take the contract that's presented to them, the kids are insured, and that's it, until they get ready to collect and they find out that they're not. This is really heartbreaking, this is really disaster. When it comes to the free economic system, when these families do move into economic disaster it's my preference that they move that economic disaster into the private industry, and into private enterprise, through the insurance industry rather than through welfare.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Senator Marsh did you wish to close? The question is then shall LB 28 be advanced to E & R. Record your vote. Have you all voted? Senator Savage voting aye.

CLERK: Savage voting aye.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Record the vote.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 6 nays, 13 not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR SAVAGE: LB 28 is advanced to E & R. Senator Koch? Senator Koch voting aye. Senator Marsh informs me that there's a group from the State Medical Auxillary in the North balcony for their state conference. Would you please rise and be recognized.

Chair recognizes Senator Murphy.

SENATOR MURPHY: Just briefly, Mr. President, congratulations Senator Kelly.

SENATOR SAVAGE: The next bill will be LB 19.

CLERK: Read title.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Chair recognizes Senator Luedtke.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move the adoption of the committee amendment to LB 19. Mr. President, members of the Legislature, the amendment is only adding the emergency clause. Senator Marsh will explain the bill.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Senator Marsh. You've heard the amendment. Indicate your vote please. Record the vote Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays to adopt the committee amendments.

SENATOR SAVAGE: The amendment is adopted. Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: Mr. Speaker, LB 19 provides for a guardian adidem to be appointed in a court procedure. Under a certain section of the law, if a child has no parent or guardian of his person, or if the parent or guardian of the person cannot be located or cannot be brought before the court,
