right now, to talk about sales tax, income tax, where it's coming from and this is the bill to do it on.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Senator Maresh.

SENATOR MARESH: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I too will vote to raise LB 430, but my intent is to amend the bill, which I told Senator Chambers, to put my bill which increases the food tax credit. I, like Senator Kelly, think this bill should be discussed. Yesterday, pardon me, day before yesterday at the Public Health and Welfare hearing we found out that these welfare recipients are not aware that they too are entitled to credit when they pay for their food. I think this is a shortcoming of the welfare workers. I think they should bring this out when they work with these people so they would understand that they can also file for a claim.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Senator Chambers, was your motion for unanimous consent?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I think we have to vote to suspend the rules. Just before I sit down, what all the other members have said so far is correct. There were various people that told me they had various reasons for wanting this bill before the body. The only thing I said was that we should discuss those reasons, and all those other things, when the bill itself is before the Legislature, rather than on the motion to raise it.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Alright, the question now is to suspend the rules to raise LB 430, despite action of the committee. Senator Dworak wanted to be recognized. Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: Is the motion to suspend the rules, or is it to raise LB 430?

SENATOR SAVAGE: Just to suspend the rules.

SENATOR DWORAK: Just to suspend the rules. Thank you.

CLERK: The motion is simply to suspend the rules that requires a motion to raise to lay over for one day.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Record your vote. Record your vote please. Have you all voted? Senator Savage voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Savage voting aye.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Senator Chambers? Record the vote.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 12 nays, 7 not voting on the motion to suspend the rules.

SENATOR SAVAGE: The motion to suspend the rules passes. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, I move that LB 430 be placed on General File notwithstanding the action of the Revenue Committee in indefinitely postponing it.
