CLERK: Mr. President, I move we request the Governor...I move that the Governor be requested to return LB 45 to the Legislature for consideration of a specific amendment. Signed Senator Hasebroock.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hasebroock.

SENATOR HASEBROOCK: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, this is a retirement bill, LB 45, and it just has one error in it. Instead of 1974, it should have been 1975 and it was caught in the Governor's office. It needs to be returned to make this correction and today is the last day we can do it. So I move that we return..request the Governor to return this bill to the Legislature.

PRESIDENT: The question is, shall the Clerk request that the Governor return LB 45. Record your vote. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 32 ayes, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion passes. Do you have matters on your desk, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Explanation of a vote. If I would have been present, I would have voted aye on LB 145. Signed Senator Marsh. Mr. President, had I been present I would have voted aye. Signed Senator Barnett. Mr. President, a Resolution will be inserted in the Journal. Identified as #19, introduced by Senator Nichol with the names attached thereto. See pages 700, 701, Journal. Mr. President, a Rule Change will be inserted in the Journal and referred to the Rules Committee by Senator Burbach. See Page 701, Journal. Mr. President, your committee on Appropriations to whom was referred LB 389 instructs me to report the same to the Legislature the recommendation it be advanced to General File; 447 General File. Signed Senator Marvel, Chairman. Mr. President, Senator Marvel asks unanimous consent to insert amendments...

PRESIDENT: There is a request for unanimous consent to insert amendments to what, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: LB 555, and did you want the explanation inserted in the Journal, also? Did you want the explanation inserted in the Journal? There is explanation and an amendment to 555. Signed, Senator Marvel.

PRESIDENT: Are there objections to the request for unanimous consent? Seeing none, the consent is granted Senator Marvel.

CLERK: That is all, Mr. President. Mr. President, I move we adjourn until 9 o'clock. Signed Senator Burbach. Wait a minute. Mr. President, notice of Committee Hearings by Judiciary, gives notice of hearings. Signed Senator Luedtke, Chairman. Mr. President, your committee on Banking, Commerce and Insurance to whom was referred LB 349 instructs me to report the same to the Legislature the recommendation it be advanced to General File; LB 463 indefinitely postponed; 528 advanced to General File. Signed Senator Murphy, Chairman. Mr. President, the Revenue Committee gives notice that an Executive Session will be held at 2:00 p.m. today. Signed Senator Cal Carsten, Chairman. Mr. President, I move we adjourn. Signed J. W. Burbach, Speaker.
