PRESIDENT: Any discussion on that motion? The question is the advancement of LB 180, as amended. All in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. The bill is so advanced.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the amendments to LB 474.

PRESIDENT: Any discussion? Question is the adoption of the amendments to LB 474. All in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. The amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, there is a request to hold LB 474 on Select File. Signed, Senator Marvel.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: We have some amendments to put on the bill and they'll be ready in a short time. I ask unanimous consent that we pass over 474.
