PRESIDENT: Senator Kennedy.

SENATOR KENNEDY: Mr. President and fellow members, just very briefly, I would certainly rise to support this very worthy bill. If you are acquainted in Norfolk we do have the rail road cutting across the main street in Norfolk. This will take many years to change these rails. With the cooperation of the county, the city, and the Federal government I'm sure this can and should be done for the safety and betterment of all these cities involved. I certainly would urge you to support this bill. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Senator Murphy.

SENATOR MURPHY: Question of Senator Barnett, if I may sir.

PRESIDENT: Senator Barnett, would you furnish information to Senator Murphy?

SENATOR BARNETT: If I can.

SENATOR MURPHY: Senator Barnett, you did say that the coal cars were causing problems?

SENATOR BARNETT: I think you could use that later on.

SENATOR MURPHY: May I ask one more question Senator Barnett? Are they acquiring the right-of-way for these new tracks by eminent domain?

SENATOR BARNETT: In some cases they do and that part is in the bill.

SENATOR MURPHY: Thank you sir.

PRESIDENT: Are you ready for the question? The question is, shall LB . . . Senator Marvel do you wish to be heard? The question is, shall LB 188 be advanced to E & R initial. Record your vote. Would you please vote. Record Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, 23 not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill is so advanced. LB 206.

CLERK: Read title.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kelly. Is there another member of the committee present? Oh, Senator Kelly.

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. President, where are we on 206?

PRESIDENT: It's on General File. Motion to advance, I think would be in order, to E & R initial.

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. President, as introducer of LB 206 I move we advance it to E & R initial.
