PRESIDENT: Motion carries. The rule change is adopted. Have you a motion?

CLERK: (mic inactivated) . . . unanimous consent to strike my name from resolution 17. Signed, Senator Warner.

Mr. President, I ask unanimous consent to bracket LB 111 on E & R final, and then insert an amendment in the Journal. Signed, Senator Warner.

PRESIDENT: Are there objections? It is so ordered.

CLERK: That is all Mr. President. I move we adjourn. Signed, Senator Burbach. .

PRESIDENT: There's a motion to adjourn. All those in favor signify by saying aye. Contrary say nay. We are adjourned.
