On page . . . the next hand-out which is request 2527 has to do with the change in the Game and Parks Commission which is allowed to spend a \$140,000 of the park cash fund and \$20,685 from the general funds so that the parks and the recreation areas can be maintained for the balance of this fiscal year. On page 4 of request number 2527, at the top, we changed the Department of Revenue, which will have a balance of \$55,000 for the general fund appropriation in the energy program. We reduced the general funds to this amount and we add, in that same Department of Revenue, \$47,232 which is the additional funding for the homestead exemption. The third new hand-out, request 2522, if you will turn to pages 8 and 9 you will find that the University of Nebraska at Lincoln has an increase of \$65,000 in the general fund. The University of Omaha has an increase of \$25,000 in the general fund, these are National Guard tuition remissions. On pages 27, 28 and 29 of this hand-out, hand-out 2522, you will find that there are technical changes in the revolving funds, cash funds, of the Med Center. There are no additions. There are simply changes in those revolving funds as requested by Pete, Marwick and Mitchel when they examined the books of the Med Center and suggested that this transfer need be made so it was easier to account for the cash funds, as far as the Med Center was concerned. On pages 32 and 33 the revolving funds of the Sun Program, which has to do with the ETV program, The School of the Year, for the University of Nebraska, is increasing those cash and revolving funds to take care of tuition that is involved. Now Mr. President I think that completes the amendments. I think maybe Senator Kelly has a question on an amendment that has to do with the technical community colleges. With your permission I'll turn the mic over to him and let him ask Senator Goodrich to answer the question.

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I'm referring specifically to the amendment that has to do with \$40,032 of general fund money for cosmetology programs at Metropolitan Technical Community College. I hereby move to amend the Marvel amendment to strike that \$40,032 from the appropriation.

PRESIDENT: Senator Mahoney.

SENATOR MAHONEY: I will defer to Senator Goodrich, then I'll speak.

PRESIDENT: Senator Barnett.

SENATOR BARNETT: I had a question on something else.

PRESIDENT: Alright. Senator Koch. We're talking now about the Kelly amend . . .

SENATOR KOCH: Is Senator Goodrich going to speak to this? Senator Goodrich, are you going to speak to this subject? Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kelly, a check of the rule persuades the Chair that your amendments out of order. Senator Goodrich. Well . . . it's here on page 37. When it's returned for Select File, for specific amendment, no other amendment may be had. Senator Goodrich. Did you want to be recognized Senator Kelly?
