PRESIDENT: No. No. He just made the announcement he authorized it. To what....

SENATOR DICKINSON: A point of order. A point of order, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: State your point to the chair.

SENATOR DICKINSON: I would like to read from a Rule in the Rule Book concerning the distribution of literature.

PRESIDENT: Read the rule.

SENATOR DICKINSON: Page 10, Rule 2, section (f), no printed or written material of any nature may be placed on the desks of the members or distributed to them in the Legislative Chamber unless such material clearly indicates on its face the person responsible for its distribution.

PRESIDENT: Senator Syas, you are out of order in distributing that before announcing who did it.

SENATOR DICKINSON: And I would like to remind Senator Syas that I...

SENATOR F. LEWIS: I wish the chair would find the smallest room possible to put Dickinson and Syas in and let them end this Papio thing once and for all.

PRESIDENT: I overrule your point of personal privilege.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Duis and Senator Clark asked to be excused at 11 o'clock.

PRESIDENT: I'd ask unanimous consent for that. Are you ready for LB 575.

CLERK: LB 575 introduced by J. W. Burbach, Speaker, at the request of the Governor. Read title. There are no amendments or other amendments.

PRESIDENT: Senator Burbach.

SENATOR BURBACH: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, this is the bill that is presented every year to the Legislature to appropriate the funds necessary to pay the salaries of the Legislators. Many of you will probably say, that's usually in another bill but through an oversight, and not intentional, I was informed by the Governor's office, that the Legislators were left out of another appropriation bill. They assured me that it was not intentional. However, we do have this bill here and I move it be advanced to E & R Initial.
