PRESIDENT: The chair recognizes Senator Savage.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, the Committee on Committees met Wednesday and report favorably upon the appointments of the following people to the Code of Ethics Board. I have five names which I would like to have you vote on as a group and so I will repeat them. Tom Doyle, State Engineer. He is reappointed to the Code of Ethics Board. William E. Peters, State Tax Commissioner, reappointed to the Code of Ethics Board and this is by statute. Also, Mr. Roy Gardner, Director of Personnel, an appointment.. a new appointment to the Code of Ethics Board and for Mr. Donald Treadway of Fullerton, Nebraska, reappointment to the Code of Ethics Board, and Mr. Charles Broderson of Herman, Nebraska, a reappointment to the Code of Ethics Board. There was a unanimous vote of the Committee of those members present. The only one, there was four absentees but the vote was 8 to 0 with four not voting. I move for the confirmation on the recommendation of the Committee on Committees of those people named.

PRESIDENT: Senator George.

SENATOR GEORGE: Mr. President, I would like to have a separate vote for each appointee.

PRESIDENT: Would you make your motion separately then, Senator Syas...Savage.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Thank you. All right. I will move that Tom Doyle, State Engineer, be reappointed to the Code of Ethics Board.

PRESIDENT: Record your vote. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Vote read. See Page 798, Journal. 26 ayes, 1 nay, 22 not voting.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries.

SENATOR SAVAGE: I move for the reappointment...

PRESIDENT: Senator Savage.

SENATOR SAVAGE: I move for the reappointment of William E. Peters, the State Tax Commissioner, to the Code of Ethics Board and I would like to point out that under the statutes that the Governor is required to appoint three people...three people from Code Agencies on this Board and two civilians and so with that explanation as to why these people are being appointed, I will move the appointment of Mr. Peters.

PRESIDENT: Any discussion. Record your vote. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Vote read. See Page 798, Journal. 25 ayes, 0 nays, 24 not voting.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. Senator Savage.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Mr. Chairman, Mr. President, the same motion for Roy Gardner, the Director of the Department of Personnel, a new appointment to the Code of Ethics Board.
