PRESIDENT: Thank you, Senator.

CLERK: OK, Mr. President, Senator Warner asked unanimous consent to withdraw the Warner amendment on page 735 to LB 111.

PRESIDENT: Is there an objection to the request? Unanimous consent is granted Senator. Chair recognizes Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Alright, there's another amendment on the desk.

CLERK: Now Mr. President, I move to . . .

SENATOR WARNER: It's got to be returned.

CLERK: Mr. President, I move to return LB 111 to Select File for specific amendment. Strike the E & R amendment number 6, found on page 687 of the Journal. Signed, Senator Warner.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, this is to correct an error that was in . . . an E & R error. The amendment that I had withdrawn merely changed a figure in the E & R amendment so the entire E & R amendment could be removed properly. That's the purpose of the amendment. I would move its adoption. I move the bill be moved back for its adoption.

PRESIDENT: There is a motion to return 111 to Select File for specific adoption. Record your vote. Excuse me, Senator Barnett.

SENATOR BARNETT: I'm sorry, I was down in front. I've got to find out which amendment he's talking about. It's not the last one? It's not the one this morning? You're not going to try that? Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Are you ready for the vote? Again the motion is to return 111 to Select File for specific amendment. Record your vote.

(Speaker Burbach presiding)

SPEAKER: Have you all voted? Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER: The bill has been brought back, that was the motion on it.

CLERK: The motion is to amend 111 by striking the E & R amendment number 6, found on page 687 of the Journal.

SPEAKER: Senator Warner. Chair recognizes Senator Warner.
