CLERK: Is this the same amendment, as I follow it, on Page 817 of the Legislative Journal?

SENATOR DWORAK: Yes.

CLERK: The amendment is as found on Page 817 of the Journal.

SENATOR DWORAK: As we explained, the Committee amendment was improperly worded and that's now corrected and we are striking the Committee amendment and the second part of this, as you see on 817, does what the Committee intended to do in the initial Committee amendment.

PRESIDENT: The question is the specific amendment offered by Senator Dworak to LB 220. Record your vote. Record, Mr. Clerk.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, can I have a Call of the House.

PRESIDENT: Record the vote. There has been a Call of the House.

SENATOR DWORAK: A Call of the House, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Dworak has made a Call. Record your vote on that. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 21 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call.

PRESIDENT: The House is under Call. Would all Senators please take their chairs and record their presence. Senator Clark and Senator Warner. Senator Burrows. Senator Dickinson.

CLERK: (inaudible) on the original motion. Senator Mills voting aye on the original motion. Senator Moylan voting aye on the original motion. Senator Dickinson, Rumery and Maresh voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kelly moves to raise the Call of the House.

CLERK: Senator Rasmussen voting aye. Senator Cavanaugh not voting. Senator Frank Lewis voting aye. Senator Fitzgerald voting aye. Senator Dick Lewis voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Now, Senator Kelly moves to raise the Call. Record your vote on the raising of the Call. Clear the Board and then vote to raise the Call. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes to raise the Call.

PRESIDENT: The Call is raised. Report the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 17 not voting, 0 nays.

PRESIDENT: The specific amendment is adopted.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move that LB 220 be advanced to Enrollment and Review for engrossment.
