LB 365 has been recommended to be placed on General File.
Signed J.R.Murphy, Chairman. Mr. President, LB 588.

PRESIDENT: Senator Clark.

SENATOR CLARK: We would like to hold LB 588 until Senator Marvel gets here. I think he will be here tomorrow morning.

PRESIDENT: It will be held over. LB 61. Senator Warner, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR WARNER: To request to pass over. I have an amendment pending. Senator Mahoney is the person (inaudible).

PRESIDENT: On 61.

SENATOR WARNER: Yes, is it not? That's correct.

PRESIDENT: Is there any objection to passing over 61.

SENATOR WARNER: I have talked with him but he is not here so...

PRESIDENT: We will move to LB 258.

CLERK: LB 258 introduced by Senator Moylan of the 6th District. Read title. There are Committee amendments by Senator Luedtke's Judiciary Committee.

PRESIDENT: Senator Luedtke.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move the adoption of the Committee amendments to LB 258. The Committee amendments are kind of an interesting turn of events on this bill and the bill, itself, was to add some items to equipment upon which you have to be careful you do not remove the serial number and when we carefully checked the law on this subject, we found that there is no penalty ever been provided for all the items mentioned in Section 28-530.01 and if there is no penalty, the law is really almost a mockery and unless somebody wants a penalty on it, why you just as well repeal the law. So what the Judiciary Committee has done, it said they couldn't go along with the proposal by Senator Moylan. However, they would just as soon repeal the whole law so the Committee amendment is to repeal 28-530.01.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion. The question is, the amendment to LB 258. Record your vote. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. Senator Luedtke.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Mr. President, I will move that LB 258 be advanced to E & R Initial since it is considerably changed in that it does repeal the whole bill. So in behalf of the Judiciary Committee, I move it be advanced to E & R Initial.

PRESIDENT: You heard the motion. Any further discussion. Record your vote. Record, Mr. Clerk. Senator Luedtke moves that the House be put under Call. Record your vote. Record, Mr. Clerk.
