PRESIDENT: Senator Schmit, your light is on. Senator Johnson. The question is, the adoption of the Rule. Record your vote. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 13 nays, 5 not voting.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. Senator Cavanaugh. Senator Burbach.

SENATOR BURBACH: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, after visiting with many of the members and especially the Chairman of committees who have bills set and because of many changes here this morning, the Revenue Committee set theirs one day ahead by the consent here of the Legislature and other members. We will go into all day sessions on March the 18th and there will be no meetings of the Chamber to begin before 2:00 p.m. in the afternoon to give those committees an opportunity to work and do their work in the noon hour. This is agreeable to the members who I have talked to and Senator Anderson, who has a group of bills and he is going to change the time to 12 o'clock, I believe. I can't find him right now.

Mr. President, your committee on Public Health to whom was referred LB 397 instructs me to report the same to General File; LB 137 indefinitely postponed. Signed Senator Kennedy, Chairman. Mr. President, your committee on Government to whom was referred LB 372 instructs me to report the same advanced to General File; LB 391 General File as amended. Mr. President, a letter from the Executive Office. Read. See Page 862, Journal. Mr. President, I move we reconsider our action on indefinitely postponing LB 202. It will be laid over, Mr. President.
