CLERK: Mr. President, Public Health Committee . . . correction. Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee gives notice of a hearing on LB 377 set for April 3rd at 1 o'clock, Signed, Senator Rasmussen, Chairman.

Mr. President, Senator Stull asked unanimous consent to print some amendments in the Legislative Journal relative to LB 193. Signed, Senator Stull.

Mr. President, your committee on Government, Military and Veterans Affairs to whom was referred LB 120 instructs me to report the same with the recommendation that it be advanced to General File; LB 4 indefinitely postponed; LB 205 indefinitely postponed; and LB 263 indefinitely postponed. Signed, Senator Rasmussen, Chairman.

That's all Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: We're ready to go on Final Reading. As you can see from your agenda this will be a very long session on Final Reading, might not be. All non-senatorial personnel please leave the floor. All Senators kindly assume your chairs. Mr. Clerk would you read on Final Reading LB 28.

CLERK: Motion on the desk, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Proceed Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I move to return LB 28 to Select File for specific amendment to strike the enacting clause. Signed, Senator Dworak.

PRESIDENT: Senator Dworak disclaims that motion.

SENATOR DWORAK: Correction, that was . . . that's an old motion up there. We acted on that last week some time. That motion shouldn't be on there. I ask for unanimous consent to withdraw the motion.

PRESIDENT: Is there any objection? Unanimous consent is granted and it's so ordered. Proceed Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Read title.

SENATOR BARNETT: Mr. President, I change from aye to no for the purposes of reconsideration. I don't think it will work.

CLERK: OK. Senator Barnett is changing from aye to nay.

SENATOR BARNETT: May I ask unanimous consent to re . . . to take that back and ask for a roll call vote at this time.
