PRESIDENT: While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign LB 81; and under the same circumstances, I propose to sign and do sign LB 195; under the same circumstances, I propose to sign and do sign LB 220; and under the same circumstances, I propose to sign and do sign LB 270; under the same circumstances, I propose to sign and do sign LB 271; under the same circumstances, I propose to sign and do sign LB 379; under the same circumstances, I propose to sign and do sign LB 489; under the same circumstances, I propose to sign and do sign LB 575. Senator Wiltse has asked me to announce that in the North balcony are some 30 fourth graders from Peru and Sheridan Elementary Schools in Auburn, Nebraska. Senator Maresh has some guests in the South balcony. They are 29 students from Meridian High School in Tobias, Nebraska. Welcome to both of you groups from the Nebraska Legislature. We are happy to have you here.

Mr. President, Senator Mills asks unanimous consent to insert amendments in the Legislative Journal to LB 287. Signed Senator Mills. Mr. President, I move to reconsider LB 310. Signed Senator Mills. Mr. President, I move to enact LB 294 notwithstanding the action of the Governor. Signed Senator Barnett. Senator Wiltse asks to be excused on the morning of March 20th. Mr. President, a new bill, LB 317A introduced by Senator Bereuter of the 24th District. Read title. See Page 956, Journal. That is all, Mr. President.

SENATOR MURPHY: Just to reconfirm that as a member not voting on that issue, I am moving to reconsider LB 240A and my request of the Attorney General is already in his office.
