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the income tax on the state level, of course? Will it decrease the property tax in the counties or will it just stay there and they will use it for something else and can it be handled under the 13% income tax that might pass this Legislature or do you want me to go one at a time? Can it be handled with the 13% increase with the total budget that this Legislature may pass?

SENATOR KELLY: Senator Syas, if you would please, I would defer answering that question for 30 days when we have this bracketed to see exactly where our budget is. I would appear to me at this time that we could accomodate LB 202 in the 13% income tax level.

SENATOR SYAS: That is your opinion.

SENATOR KELLY: That is my opinion but that may be wrong when we are 30 days farther down the road, Senator.

SENATOR SYAS: All right. How about the sales?

SENATOR KELLY: I would say that it would be accomodated in the 2 1/2% sales tax, also. Now that, again, may change when we are 30 days down the road.

SENATOR SYAS: Well, I can't go for a sales tax increase.

SENATOR KELLY: No sir. I believe that the 2 1/2% will cover and the 13% income tax will accomodate 202 just fine.

SENATOR SYAS: Now just one other thing. Is Senator Marvel... have you got anything to add to be helpful under this situation? You are the skillful one on financing and I am certainly not.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marvel's light is on, Senator Skarda. Senator Cope.

SENATOR COPE: A question for Senator Kelly.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kelly, can you respond to Senator Cope's question.

SENATOR KELLY: Yes sir, if he would repeat?

SENATOR COPE: I would like to ask this question just for the records. The federal government picks up 57% and the state 23% at the present time?

SENATOR KELLY: That is correct and the counties the balance.

SENATOR COPE: I think that that is enough. I think we are doing our share and as a member of the Revenue Committee, I would question the remark that the 13%, at the present time, would take care of this additional after hearing a report the other day. I don't think that that is...it could be an inaccuracy.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: Is it my turn or did somebody ask a question.

PRESIDENT: It is your turn, Senator.
