Labor Committee reports 556 indefinitely postponed. Signed, Senator Maresh.

Judiciary Committee reports LB 574 General File as amended. Signed, Senator Luedtke.

CLERK: Motion on the desk, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Would Senator Barnett sit up please.

CLERK: The motion is I move to suspend the rules and take up the rule change previously referred to the Rules Committee. Signed, W. Barnett.

PRESIDENT: Any discussion on the motion to amend the rules? Senator Barnett.

SENATOR BARNETT: Mr. Chairman, I'd move that . . . about 30 people here. It takes every one of them to agree. There's no reason they shouldn't though.

PRESIDENT: Is this noncontroversial?

SENATOR BARNETT: This is noncontroversial. It's on page 971 of the Journal. I know some of the people that were going to help me visit about this on the floor are not here.
