CLERK: LB 318 introduced by the Agriculture and Environment Committee and signed by the members thereof. Read title. There are Committee amendments, Mr. President, by Senator Schmit's Agriculture Committee.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. Chairman, the Committee amendments harmonize the Commercial Feed Law of the state of Nebraska with the federal law. That is all they do. If they require further explanation, I will attempt to do so but the Department of Agriculture feels that it is in the interest of the industry and the industry agrees that the state law be in harmony and agreement with federal statutes and that is all the bill does. I move that the Committee amendments be adopted.

PRESIDENT: Any discussion on the Committee amendments? The question is, the adoption of the Committee amendments. Record your vote. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, on the motion to adopt the Committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I move the bill be advanced to E & R as amended.

PRESIDENT: Is there any discussion? The chair is going to take a little longer than we do on Select File on this because even though we all want to get work done we certainly don't want to stifle any legitimate debate. Seeing none, the question is the advancement of LB 318. Record your vote. Record, Mr. Clerk

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. LB 391.

CLERK: LB 391 introduced by Senator Burbach of the 19th District. Read title. The bill was first considered February 11th and laid over. There are Committee amendments by Senator Rasmussen's Government Committee.

PRESIDENT: Senator Rasmussen is not here.

CLERK: Yes, he is.

PRESIDENT: Where? Oh, he is hard to see.

SENATOR RASMUSSEN: Mr. Chairman, members of the body, this bill was heard in our Committee and the amendment is the bill and it very explicitly states exactly where state jurisdiction will come in, such as Vets Hospital in Omaha, Lincoln, Grand Island and the Maxwell Cementary out west. I would ask for the adoption of the amendments.

PRESIDENT: The question is the adoption of the amendments to LB 391. Is there any discussion? Record your vote. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays.

PRESIDENT: The amendments are adopted. Senator Burbach.
