PRESIDENT: Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 303 to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Any discussion? The question is the advancement of LB 303, as amended, to E & R final. All in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. The bill, as amended, is advanced.

Senator Marvel has asked the Chair to recognize 21 ninth graders from Hastings area in the North balcony. Welcome to the Legislature. Glad to have you here.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 67 was previously returned pursuant to a motion by Senator Clark for a specific amendment. That specific amendment is now pending.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Clark.

SENATOR CLARK: Mr. President, will you read the amendment please.

PRESIDENT: Mr. Clerk, could you read the amendment.

CLERK: On page 2, line 25, after "any" insert "any" and reinstate the stricken matter commencing with "city" in line 25 through "the" in line 27. On page 3, lines 1 to 3 reinstate the stricken matter through the word "such", and insert following the word "such", "cities retail service area". Signed, Senator Clark.

SENATOR CLARK: The only thing . . . as I say this amendment does put it back in its original form. I amended it for the REA's. They decided, through their attorney, that it had to be back at its original form. I think the problem with the bill is getting two attorneys involved. Outside of that it was alright. Is that right Mr. Clerk . . . or Mr. Speaker?

PRESIDENT: You've got two of them up here.

SENATOR CLARK: I know, that's my problem.

PRESIDENT: We have nothing to do with this.

SENATOR CLARK: I would move for the adoption of the amendments.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion on the motion? The Clerk says you're in trouble, Senator.

SENATOR CLARK: I know that.

PRESIDENT: The question is the adoption of the amendment, as explained by attorney . . . or Senator Clark. Record your vote. Have you voted on Senator Clark's motion? Record Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, 24 not voting.
