CLERK: Mr. President, there is a motion on the desk. I move to return 255 to Select File for specific amendment. The specific amendment is to strike "One Hundred" and insert "Seventy-Five". Signed Senator Chambers.

PRESIDENT: The chair recognizes Senator Chambers.

CLERK: He seems to have stepped out. Mr. President, I have some Committee reports. Your committee on Agriculture to whom was referred LB 404 instructs me to report the same to the Legislature the recommendation it be advanced to General File as amended. Signed Senator Schmit, Chairman. Mr. President, your committee on Enrollment and Review reports we have examined and reviewed LB 67 and find the same correctly engrossed; 302 correctly engrossed; 335 correctly engrossed; 437 correctly engrossed; 448 correctly engrossed; 480 correctly engrossed; 493 correctly engrossed. Signed Senator Dworak, Chairman. Mr. President, your committee reports we have examined and reviewed LB 295 and find the same correctly enrolled; 277 correctly enrolled.

PRESIDENT: We will take up Senator Chambers motion to return LB 255 to Select File for a specific amendment. Excuse me, we will take care of some bill signing. While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign LB 277. Under the same circumstances, I propose to sign and do sign LB 295. The chair recognizes Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this is a bill which Senator Kennedy and I discussed on the floor the other day relative to the cost of taking an examination to enter the practice of veterinarian medicine in the state and a one hundred dollar figure was put into the bill. He and I discussed it and he and they agreed to reduce that amount to \$75. So the purpose of returning the bill to Select File is to add this specific amendment which would change the \$100 figure to \$75 and there is agreement, at least among us, on it. Perhaps other members of the body would disagree but that is the specific amendment.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion on the motion to return for specific amendment. That is the question. Record your vote. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 2 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion passes. The bill is returned. Senator Chamber.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I move the adoption of this amendment which would substitute \$75 for \$100 with reference to this examination fee.

PRESIDENT: Discussion on the motion. Record your vote. Senator Mills.

SENATOR MILLS: Mr. President, a question of Senator Chambers.
