PRESIDENT: Are you calling for the previous question?

SENATOR KEYES: Oh no. I believe everybody has the right to talk.

PRESIDENT: Senator Lewis.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Since that is my county too, I'd officially like to go on record in support of LB 315.

PRESIDENT: Senator Dickinson. There is no further... Senator Koch. The question is, shall the bill as amended be advanced? Record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. The bill is advanced. Senator Burbach.

SENATOR BURBACH: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I have just been informed that Senator Richard Lewis does not want to take up LB 113 at this time so I would advise the Clerk that we should continue on with out General File until 11:45 a.m. At that time, Senator Savage will have a list of three names for confirmation by this body but we just as well continue until 11:45 a.m.

CLERK: Mr. President, on LB 458, there is a request to bracket the bill by Senator Johnson.

PRESIDENT: Request unanimous consent to bracket LB 458. Are there objections. Seeing none, it is so ordered.

CLERK: LB 475 introduced by Senator Fowler of the 27th District. Read title. There are Committee amendments by Senator Maresh's Labor Committee.

PRESIDENT: Is Senator Maresh in the Chamber? Senator Fowler, would you like to address yourself to this matter?

SENATOR FOWLER: Ya, I move for adoption of the Committee amendment. What the Committee amendment is about is to give the Labor Department a period of June 1st before the act will become effective. The way the law is written now it would have become effective upon passage or it was suggested that it become effective upon passage. The Labor Department wanted a certain amount of time to gear up for the request. Senator Maresh is here and he might want to add to that statement on the Committee amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Maresh, Senator Fowler has done an excellent job. Do you want to add to it before voting on your Committee amendments? All right. The question then is, shall the Committee amendments be adopted? Record your vote. Will you please vote. Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, remainder not voting on motion to adopt.
