PRESIDENT: The request was for any bills that are ready for Final Reading, wasn't it Senator Burbach?

SENATOR BURBACH: This is the request that I'm talking about.

SENATOR BARNETT: Right, and there are five of them listed.

SENATOR BARNETT: I have LB 564, I believe, with the emergency clause on it, what we need for University Place in my district. It's a parking bill. It's not controversial at all. I wish it could be read.

SENATOR BURBACH: LB 20 and 564 will then be considered for Final Reading this morning.

PRESIDENT: We are on Final Reading. Mr. Clerk would you read, for the final time, LB 20. All non-senatorial personnel please leave the floor. All Senators remain in your chairs. Would the Sergeant-at-Arms secure the members to the chamber.

CLERK: Read title.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 20 pass. Record your vote. Record.
